This course is designed for those new to the medical field and includes clinical and classroom training. The course includes approximately 112 hours of New Hampshire Board of Nursing-approved training with the option to become licensed in New Hampshire, Vermont, or both states to maximize your career opportunities. Students will learn the basics of patient care in this hands-on, facility-based training to develop skills in real world situations.

**Requirements for Enrollment**

To be eligible for enrollment in this LNA course, students must:

- \* Complete an initial interview to review requirements of the course
- \* Demonstrate math and reading skills at or beyond the 9th grade level
- \* Complete a Mantoux Test and test negative for active tuberculosis
- \* Complete immunizations as needed
- \* Complete criminal record checks in VT and NH
- \* Be at least 16 years old

**Job Outlook**

According to the US DOL, employment of nursing assistants and orderlies is projected to grow 11 percent from 2016 to 2026, faster than the average for all occupations. According to VDOL, LNAs in northern Vermont earn on average \$14.57 per hour.
